

Application for Placement of Fixed Protection at Enchanted Rock State Natural Area

All applications will be evaluated on a case by case basis. Application approval or disapproval by the Central Texas Climbing Committee (CTCC) will be determined within two calendar months following the receipt of the application. Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) has agreed to act on CTCC approved applications within one month of TPWD receipt. Applications are accepted in person by CTCC members, or at the following address:

Application Rules:

1. All Park and Application rules and regulations must be observed.
2. All placements of bolts at Enchanted Rock State Natural Area (ERSNA) must be approved by the CTCC and TPWD.
3. All application information must be completed or the application is subject to rejection.
4. Applications must be signed by all applicants.
5. Only application signees will be eligible to install the applied for bolts and hardware.
6. Applications may be submitted to a CTCC current member, or to the ERSNA Park Superintendent.
7. Every application must include a topo or photo showing the number and location of all proposed placements (see back).
8. Applications for routes or protection that cannot be precisely located will be rejected.
9. Approved applications are valid for one year from the date of approval.
10. An individual may only have two approved applications active at any given time.
11. Placement of all approved bolts will be deemed completion of the application.
12. Applications may be withdrawn in writing by the applicant at any time.
13. All fixed protection must be of a type approved by the CTCC: standards are minimum of stainless steel 1/2" x 2 3/4" Powers Fasteners (RAWL) or equivalent 5 piece bolts and stainless steel

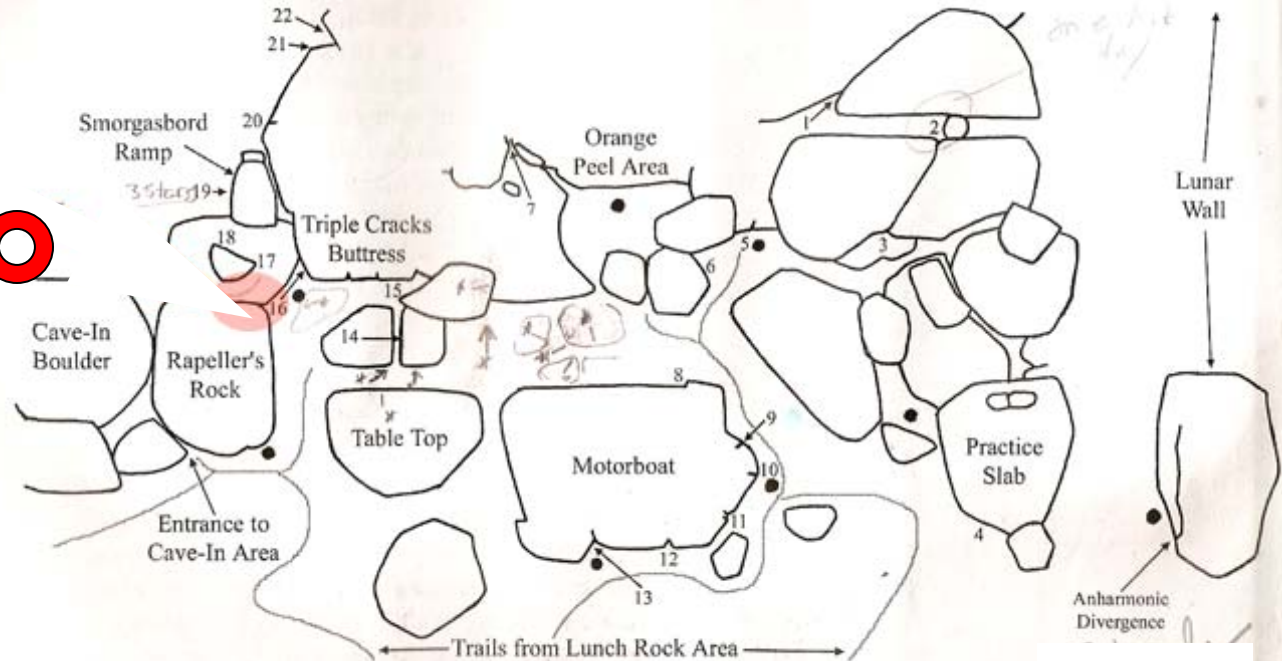

Motorboat and Triple Cracks Area

From the Lunch Rock area take the right-most trail (i.e., the Triple Cracks Trail) up the short slab of rock. After about 50 feet, the trail will split. The right branch (Motorboat Trail) takes you to Practice Slab, Motorboat Rock, Jackknife Boulder, and nearby problems while the left branch heads toward the Triple Cracks and Cave-In Areas. If you want to take the left trail to the problems near Triple Cracks and Cave-In, be aware that the trail will split again and you need to take the right branch which heads uphill. The left branch cuts back down to the trail by the creek and heads around to the back of Main Dome. Be aware that the topo below has been rotated 90 degrees to the left (to fit the page) from its orientation on page 106 and therefore north

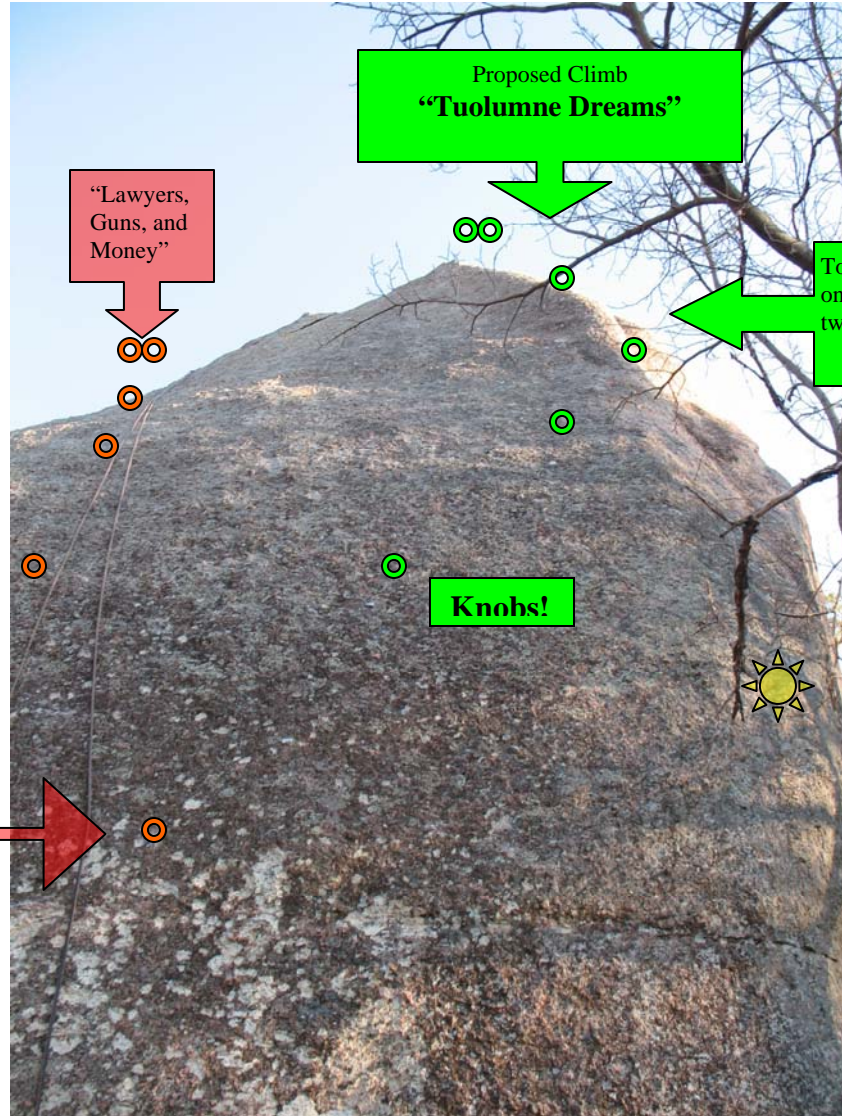
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This symbol is a reference marker in both photos.
